Requirements for receiving 1st Holy Communion at Our Lady of the Cedars Maronite Catholic Church

- 1st Holy Communion is received in the 3rd grade if:
 - Student has completed 2 years of CCE preparation (attended 2nd and 3rd grade classes) at OLC
 - Student attends CCE at OLC on a regular basis (attendance is checked)
 - Student's family is registered and active at OLC
 - Student attends all extended 1stHoly Communion preparation classes & practices
 - When the registration for the ceremony is sent out, Parent/Guardian signs student up for, and pays the fees associated with, the 1st Holy Communion Ceremony
- If you are new to the Parish and your child is in 4th grade or above, when registering your child for CCE Classes, please let the Director of Religious Education, or Father, know that your child will need to receive the sacrament.
- If your child attends a catholic school and is participating in 1st Holy Communion preparation with his/her class and will be receiving their 1st communion in 2nd grade, they may get permission to participate in the sacrament at OLC with the 3rd grade communicants if:
 - You provide the office with proof of enrolment in a catholic school
 - The child attends CCE class at OLC on a regular basis
 - The family is registered and active at OLC
 - The child attends all extended 1st Holy Communion preparation classes and practices
 - When the registration for the ceremony is sent out, Parent/Guardian signs student up for, and pays the fees associated with, the 1st Holy Communion Ceremony
